

Ernst Haas AutumnColor Print Fetches \$17,500 at Sotheby's

A copy of Ernst Haas', "Route 66, Albuquerque, N.M.," printed by AutumnColor brought a closing bid of \$17,500 at an October 5th photo auction at Sotheby's, New York City.

The pre-event estimate was \$10,000 - \$15,000.

The 40 1/2" x 61" print was made by AutumnColor in March 2010 for the Ernst Haas estate. Ernst Haas made the original image in 1969.

The Sotheby's auction catalog described the print as: "oversized chromogenic print, framed, a Hass Studio, New York label with title, date, edition '12/15' printing information, and signed by Alexander Haas in ink, on the reverse, 1969, printed in March 2010 (In America, pl. 93)."
